Day 1: USA - Amsterdam Overnight flight to Amsterdam.

Day 2: Amsterdam Board the *ms Amalegro*, your deluxe river cruise ship for the next seven nights. Meet travelers at tonight's **Welcome Dinner**. Meals: (D)

Day 6: Ghent Take a guided sightseeing tour of Ghent, the fourth largest city of Belgium. The city center alone is a



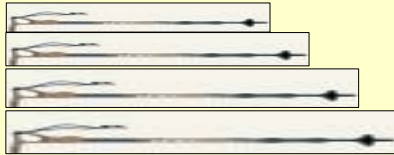

Day 7: Willemstad - Dordrecht Sail through the Dutch region of Zeeland, where you'll see the Delta Works. Stop in charming Willemstad for a walking tour. Sail towards Dordrecht and the 18th-century windmills of Kinderdijk—the largest group of original windmills in Holland. Meals: (B, L, D)

Day 8: Utrecht-Keukenhof-Amsterdam Cruise from Dordrecht along the Amsterdam-Rhine Canal to Utrecht. Take an excursion to the famous Keukenhof Gardens to see a spectacular displays of bulb flowers.
