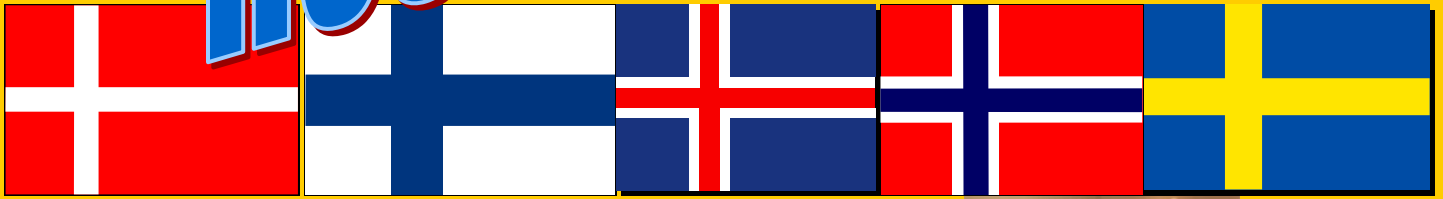

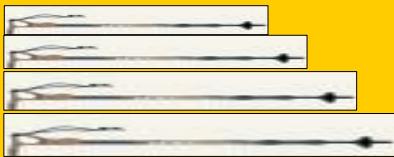


As a bonus to the festival, you're going to the Gaither Vocal Band and Daniel O'Donnell concerts. You're not going to want to miss this unique trip!

Scale of 1-4 Walking sticks

One Walking Stick: Can board motorcoach. Easy walking. Developed surfaces.

Two Walking Sticks: Able to board all types of transportation easily. Must be a steady walker and able to negotiate developed and uneven terrain ranging from pavement, dirt trails and cobblestones.

Three Walking Sticks: Longer, more difficult walking and/or hiking required. Must be sure footed and have a good sense of balance to participate in these activities. More stamina required.

Four walking sticks: Excellent physical shape. High exertion level. Balance necessary.

Itinerary

Sept. 30th- Whitefish passengers catch their train at the Whitefish Amtrak Station while Great Falls travelers will shuttle to Shelby and join the group at the Shelby Amtrak Station. Travel to Williston, ND for first night's stay.

Oct. 1st - Motorcoach will transfer the group to Minot, ND to the Hostfest Grounds. Your luggage will be delivered to your room where you will spend the next two nights. Enjoy the Gaither Vocal Band America's premier Gospel vocal band at the 1pm concert. Spend the rest of the day at your leisure at the Hostfest Festival. There is food, entertainment and activities that will surely fill your day!
Meals: Breakfast

Oct. 2nd - Begin the day with a continental breakfast. Catch the shuttle back to the fairgrounds and spend the day at your own pace. This evening we have group tickets to see the fabulous Daniel O'Donnell perform at the 7pm Concert. Meal: Breakfast

Oct 3rd - Be sure to grab breakfast before the morning bus takes us to the Minot Amtrak Station. Once you board the train for your return trip home, take time to rest and relax as you recall the fun. Return home with many memories of the Hostfest. Meal: Breakfast

***PRICE IS BASED ON DOUBLE OCCUPANCY AND INCLUDES:** Round trip Amtrak train fare, Motorcoach transfer from Williston to Minot, ND, Shuttle tickets from hotel to Hostfest (fairgrounds) daily, One MWB and one FHTS travel escorts, 3 nights budget/moderate accommodations (one night in Williston, ND at Missouri Flats Inn, 2 nights accommodations at the Vegas Hotel Minot, ND), Luggage handling, Meals: 3 Continental Breakfasts, Concert tickets as per itinerary and escort & bus driver gratuities. **Please note: Due to the limited availability of rooms, travelers need to understand that non-smoking rooms not available and there are no elevators at this hotel. DEPARTURE CITIES: Great Falls and Whitefish only.

SPACES AVAILABLE: Limited to 30 seats from Great Falls and 30 seats from Whitefish.

PAYMENT POLICY: \$300 per person non-refundable deposit is required to book and secure your seat. Balance due July 1st, 2010.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Cancellations will result in the loss of the entire \$300.00 deposit. No refunds on cancellations made 90—0 days of event. Cancellations should be made in person, via first class mail or by telephone. Cancellations through voice or email will not be binding.
