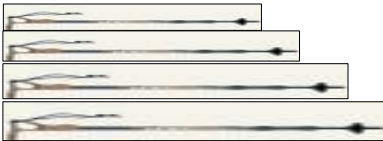
ITINERARY:

Day 1: Travel by motorcoach to Spokane, Washington. Check into The Davenport Towers for a two night stay. Tonight, enjoy the atmosphere of the grand Davenport Hotel in downtown Spokane and dine at your leisure. Dinner is on your own.

Day 2: Use your breakfast voucher at one of the Davenport restaurants. This morning gives you the opportunity to explore the downtown Spokane area. Great shopping is within walking distance, visit the River Front Park and find a lunch stop, or treat yourself to a ride on the carousel or sky ride. Complementary rides within a two mile distance are provided by The Davenport. Early afternoon, you'll take the tour of your choice to either the Cat Tales Zoological Park, or you'll join your guide for a Historical Tour of the Davenport Hotel. After the tours, you'll have time to change your clothes and freshen up for the evenings' activities. Start with a delicious dinner, then take your orchestra level seats to watch the elaborate production of Disney's "Lion King". Return to the hotel.

Day 3: Use your breakfast voucher at one of the Davenport restaurants. Walking sticks

One Walking Stick: Can board motorcoach. Easy walking. Developed surfaces.
